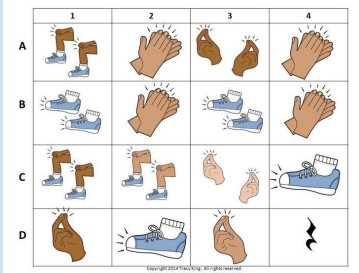


Screen Free From Piddle Valley

Mrs Chant says:

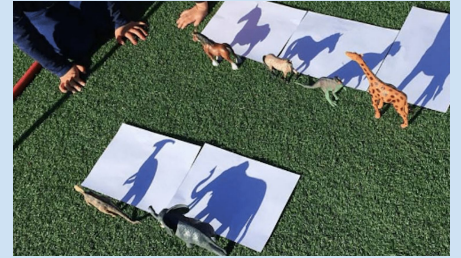
“Make drawings float and dance using a whiteboard pen and water!”
